

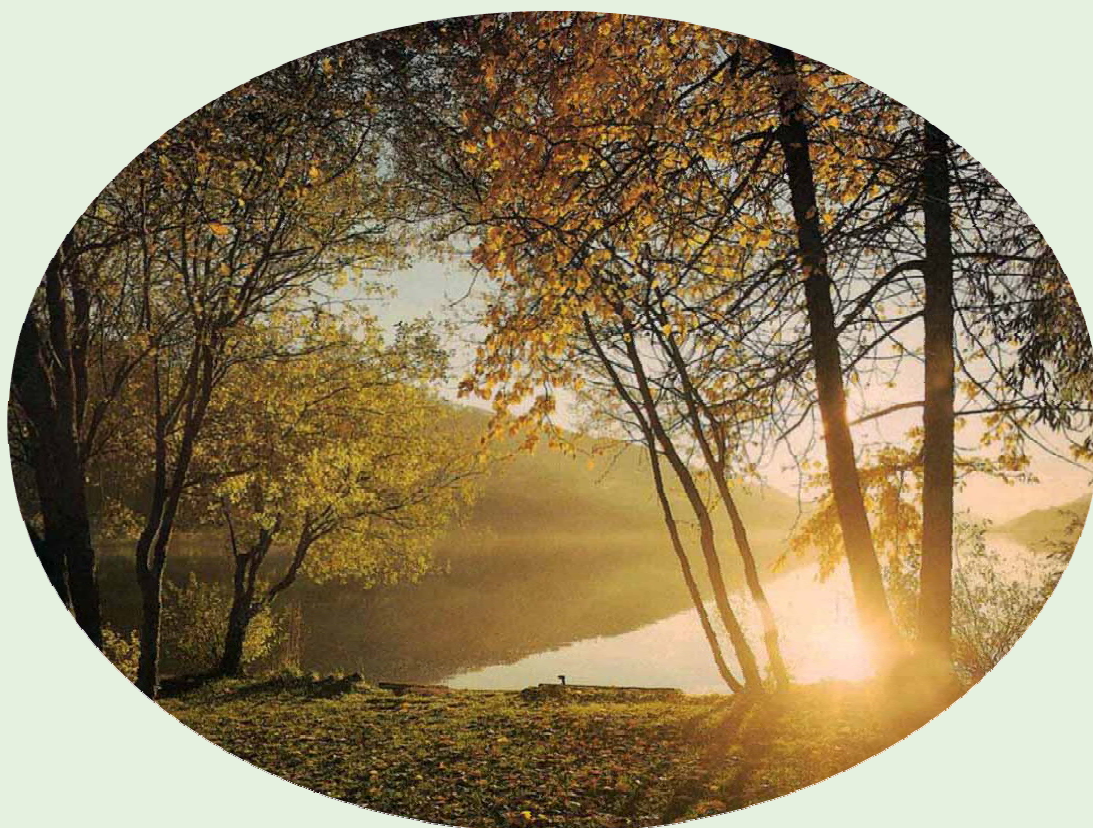

## □ INVITATION

Dear Colleague,

## □ CALL FOR PAPERS AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

A Book of Abstracts containing abstracts of all lectures and posters will be distributed to all participants upon registration at the Conference desk. The electronic version of the Abstracts will be placed to the Conference Home Page and will be available via Internet as soon as they are accepted.

All participants are invited to present Oral Communications or Posters at the Conference on their recent research. The Organizing Committee will select a limited number of Oral Communications.

Participants wishing to present a Poster or an Oral Communication will need to send an e-mail with abstract in .RTF or .DOC format to Conference Secretary by July 01, 2005. The format and guidelines for submitting the Abstract are described below. Printed copies of Abstracts sent by ordinary mail or by fax will not be accepted.

Notifications of selection of Abstracts as Oral Presentations will be mailed to the author by August 10, 2005.

The Abstract (no longer than 1 page) should be prepared in English in the Microsoft Word format and may include any graphics, pictures, formulas, schemes, etc. Preferable software for chemical drawings is ChemDraw from the ChemOffice package.

The Abstract should be prepared on paper of A4 (21.0 x 29.7cm) size with 3 cm margins.

The Abstract should start with the title, author(s)' name(s) and address followed by the main body of the Abstract. The title should be centered and in bold 16pt Times Roman with initial capital letters. The name(s) of the author(s) (including the first name, middle initial(s) and family name) should be centered and in normal 12pt Times Roman, with the name of the presenting author underlined. The author's full address (italics, 10pt Times Roman) should be centered; fax number and E-mail address are desirable. The body text of the Abstracts should be in normal 12pt Times Roman (1.2-1.5 line spacing). All figures should be located within the text at the appropriate positions.

MS Word template for the preparation of the Abstract is available for downloading from the Conference web-page.

The electronic version of the Abstract should be sent as an attached file by e-mail to the Conference Secretariat no later than July 01, 2005. Abstracts received after this date or not prepared according to these instructions may not be included to the Book of Abstracts.

### ***Some technical details for oral presentations***

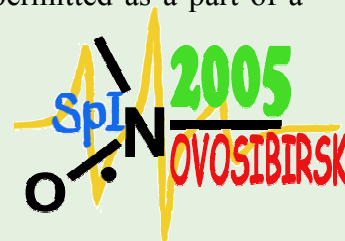
All sessions will have one data projector, one laptop, one laser pointer, and one projection screen. All computer based presentations will use MS PowerPoint. Authors must insure that their PowerPoint presentations meets the following requirements:

- created in Windows format only (no Mac or Linux)
- recorded on CD, DVD or USB portable memory device
- compatible with MS PowerPoint 2000

In addition, PowerPoint authors must contact with Organizing Committee one day prior to their presentation to transfer their PowerPoint file and to insure that their presentation will work correctly. MS PowerPoint is the only supported format. If you would like to use overhead or slide projector please contact Organizing Committee in advance. Also you may use your own laptop computer.

### ***Some technical details for poster presentations***

Poster will be displayed on poster boards. These boards measure 90 cm high by 120 cm wide. Please reserve a free space for the poster number in the upper right-hand corner (10 cm high by 15 cm wide). Free-standing displays and sound/projecting equipment are not permitted as a part of a poster.
