Scientific Scope and Program

The scope of the Conference includes:

- Isolation, purification, and identification of natural compounds
- Synthetic transformations of natural compounds
- Natural products derivatives application in medicinal chemistry
- Nutraceuticals and bioadditives of plant and marine origin
- New trends in technology and biotechnology of natural products for production of medicals, cosmetics, nutraceuticals, and agricultural preparations

The Conference will include oral communications (20-30 min) and poster sessions. Participation by correspondence is also possible.

Language

The official language of the Conference will be English. The working languages are Russian and Korean.

CALL FOR PAPERS AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

Conference proceedings will apply to the Book of Abstracts with abstracts of all lectures, posters, and presentations by correspondence and will be distributed to all participants upon registration at the Conference desk. The electronic version of the Abstracts will be placed to the Conference web-page and will be available via Internet.

All participants are invited to present Oral Communications or Posters at the Conference on their recent research.

Participants wishing to present a Poster or an Oral Communication or to participate by correspondence will need to send an e-mail with abstract in .RTF or .DOC format to the **Conference Secretariat** (conf2010@nioch.nsc.ru) by February 1, 2010. The format and guidelines for submitting the Abstract are described below. Printed copies of Abstracts sent by ordinary mail or by fax will not be accepted.

The Abstract (no longer than 1 page) should be prepared in English and may include any graphics, pictures, formulas, schemes etc.

The Abstract should be prepared on paper of A4 (21.0×29.7 cm) size with 2.5 cm margins.

The abstract should start with the title, author(s)' name(s) and address(es) followed by the main body of the abstract. The title should be centered and typed in bold 16pt Times Roman with initial capital letters. The name(s) of the author(s) (including the first name, middle initial(s) and family name) should be centered and typed in normal 12pt Times Roman, with the name of the *presenting* author underlined, the *corresponding* author should be indicated with an asterisk and contact details (fax, e-mail) should be given. Use superscript numbers to indicate different addresses which should be as detailed as possible. The authors' full addresses (italics 10pt Times Roman) should be centered.

The text of the abstracts should be typed in normal 12pt Times Roman (1.2-1.5 line spacing). All figures should be located within the text at the appropriate positions. Citations for the literature referenced in a page should be listed at the end of the page, they should be typed in normal 10pt Times Roman and be designed as in Tetrahedron style (www.elsevier.com/wps/find/journaldescription.cws_home/942/authorinstructions).

MS Word template for the preparation of the Abstract is available for downloading from the **Conference web-page** (www.nioch.nsc.ru/conf2010/docs/abstract_template.doc).

The electronic version of the Abstract should be sent as an attached file by e-mail to the **Conference Secretariat** (conf2010@nioch.nsc.ru) no later than on February 1, 2010. Abstracts received after this date or not prepared according to these instructions may not be included to the Book of Abstracts.

The Organizing Committee will select the limited number of Oral Communications. Notifications of selection of Abstracts as Oral Presentations will be mailed to the author by February 10, 2010.

Some technical details for oral presentations

Presentation should be prepared in English. Authors must contact with Organizing Committee one day prior to their presentation to transfer their file and to insure that their presentation will work correctly.

Some technical details for poster presentations

Poster will be displayed on poster boards (100 cm high and 120 cm wide). Free-standing displays and sound/projecting equipment are not permitted as a part of a poster.

Visas

Residents of countries of the Commonwealth of Independent States (CIS) are required to have a valid passport.

Korean and the non-CIS countries residents are required to have both a valid passport and a visa.

Korean participants are recommended to communicate with [Dr. Byung Hun Um](#) (Co-Chairman) regarding requirements for getting a visa.

Residents of the other non-CIS countries should check with their local travel agents visa requirements for travel to Russia.
